#### THE PREACHING OF THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH - PART 2

Acts 20:1-12 | Pastor T. H. Moore

In Acts chapter twenty, the apostle Paul and his missionary team are nearing the end of his third missionary journey. They traveled through Macedonia and into Greece, where they spent three months. They then returned back through Macedonia and then on to Troas. This missionary team consisted of Sopater of Berea, Aristarchus and Secundus of Thessalonica, Gaius and Timothy of Derbe, and Tychichus and Trophimus of Asia. When they arrived at Troas, they spent the Lord's day at the church in Troas, and in Acts 20:7, we read the phrase, "Paul preached unto them."

The most important activity that happens in a church meeting is the preaching of the Word of God. Preaching is defined as "proclaiming the truths of the Bible and declaring the gospel of Jesus Christ." As we get closer and closer to the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, we should be hearing more and more preaching—but we are not! In fact, there are so many other things that take place on the Lord's day in the house of God that preaching has taken a back seat. However, the local New Testament church is still supposed to be "... the pillar and ground of the truth."

Last week, we began to look at some Bible truths as we consider, "The Preaching of the New Testament Church." We saw:

### I. The Subject of Our Preaching (vs. 7a)

## II. The Supernatural Work of Preaching (vs. 7b)

We read in verse 7, "... and continued his speech until midnight." I want you to imagine

these men as they came together. Paul, Timothy, Luke, and those previously named were all in this meeting. This meeting was filled with men who were companions and co-laborers of Paul. There were more than likely church members who were there as well, but many of these men were preachers themselves, and as they were gathered, Paul preached to them until midnight. My point is, there was a great emphasis on preaching! Why the emphasis? Because preaching is the primary method that God uses to accomplish His work in our hearts. It is through preaching that God does His supernatural work! We read in 1 Corinthians 1:21, "For after that in the wisdom of God the world by

wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe." Then, in 1 Corinthians 2:1-4, "And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified. And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power."

Think about the work that Bible preaching does in our

hearts. 2 Timothy 3:15-17 says, "And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." It is the Word of God that makes us wise unto salvation. It is the Word of God that teaches us doctrine, reproves us, corrects us, and instructs us in righteousness so that we may be perfect (complete, mature), throughly furnished unto all good works.

A child of God that needs help should not be looking to tenstep programs, secular books, therapy, treatments, medication, or rehabilitation. What a child of God needs more than anything else is the uninterrupted, unadulterated Word of God, because it is the Word of God that does the spiritual work in the hearts of God's people. The greatest counseling that one can get is from the pulpit of a Bible-believing, Bible-preaching church where the pastor faithfully and accurately delivers the Word of God service after service.

We read in 2 Kings 17:13 how God sent His prophets to speak to His people, "Yet the LORD testified against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, ...."

There is something deeply wrong in a Christian's heart if they do not like Bible preaching, because when our heart is right with God, we desire to hear from God—and God speaks to us through preaching!
